SUBJECT: CEREMONIAL BANNERS

Brewton-Parker College authorizes the use and display of ceremonial banners for various meetings and functions of the institution.

Ceremonial banners shall be maintained, utilized, and displayed according to the following guidelines:

- The banners may be carried in the processional and/or displayed at academic convocations. The Academic Council may approve other events or occasions at which to display the banners. Additionally, the Provost may authorize the use of any or all of the banners if the Academic Council is not available.
- Requests to use any or all of the ceremonial banners for events at external sites or off-campus should be made to the Academic Council, or to the Provost if the Council is not available. Any banners representing individual external site locations/programs shall be the sole responsibility of the director of the respective external site.
- Banners representing the academic divisions, the Library, and External Programs shall be hung and/or displayed at the same approximate height when possible. Any banner representing the entire institution, however, may be hung/displayed at a higher height if desired.
